



Fitzgerald Family at 90 East Woodland Rd., Spring 1945

Michael and Agnes Fitzgerald moved with their family to Lake Forest from Milwaukee in 1878 to a farm near the current location of the Onwentsia Club. Michael and his father Edward both served in the Cival War. Michael's sons Charles B. and John E. both established competing plumbing companies. Charles owned Lake Forest Plumbing and Heating located in Market Square, while John owned the J.E. Fitzgerald Plumbing and Heating Company on Deerpath.

Charles married Agnes Harding and John married her sister, Ida. In 1910, Charles built a home at 90 East Woodland Rd. The couple had three sons, Charles II, Francis Barry and Austen. Francis Barry was the first baby ever to be baptized in the new Church of St. Mary on its dedication day in 1910. For 20 years, Barry owned a cigar and candy store in town. Austen had four children with his wife Louise. Their second son, Ray has been the owner of Fitzgerald's Photography for over 25 years. Charles II married Lillian Green and moved to 7 North June Terrace in 1949. They had three girls and one son, Charles III. Charles III married Joan Krasss in 1957. The couple has three children: Sharon, Charles IV and Michael.

The Fitzgeralds boast of having three generations as active volunteers for the Lake Forest Fire Department. There are seven generations of Fitzgeralds that have lived in Lake Forest.
